



How to make the most of a virtual fair ...

Virtual fairs can be difficult to navigate but they are important for your research, so here are some useful tips to stay on track

How to prepare

- Create a list of features that you want from a University e.g. courses, sandwich/placement year, study abroad, societies etc.
- Prepare a list of questions
- Register on UCAS hub to browse through courses/university choices

During the fair

- Browse or bookmark any useful resources that Universities share
- Order a prospectus
- Make a note or sign up to virtual open days or planned events
- Do a virtual tour and make notes of what you like/what you don't like
- Ask your questions

Continue your research

- Attend the virtual events you signed up to
- Visit University course websites for more information (e.g. check entry requirements, modules and assessment types etc.)
- Attend virtual open days and join subject academic talks

You're in control of your next steps. By completing the above, you can begin to narrow down your options and find the right University choice for you.
